Detailed Report:

The Git & GitHub Workshop was organized by CSI-DBIT on 14 August, 2026 (Friday) from 03:00 PM to 05:00 PM at IT Lab 05 & IT Lab 06, 3rd Floor, A Wing, Don Bosco Institute of Technology (DBIT), Kurla. The session was coordinated by Prof. Udaychandra Nayak, CSI-DBIT Student Branch Counselor.

Session Highlights

The workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across multiple departments, creating an engaging and collaborative learning environment. Attendees explored both theoretical concepts and practical aspects of version control, including Git commands, repository management, and collaboration workflows on GitHub. The hands-on exercises provided real-world experience, enabling students to work confidently on projects and contribute to open-source platforms.

Hands-On Git Challenge

Participants practiced a real-world Git workflow involving repository setup, branching, committing, pushing, and managing pull requests collaboratively, with a prize pool of ₹2000.

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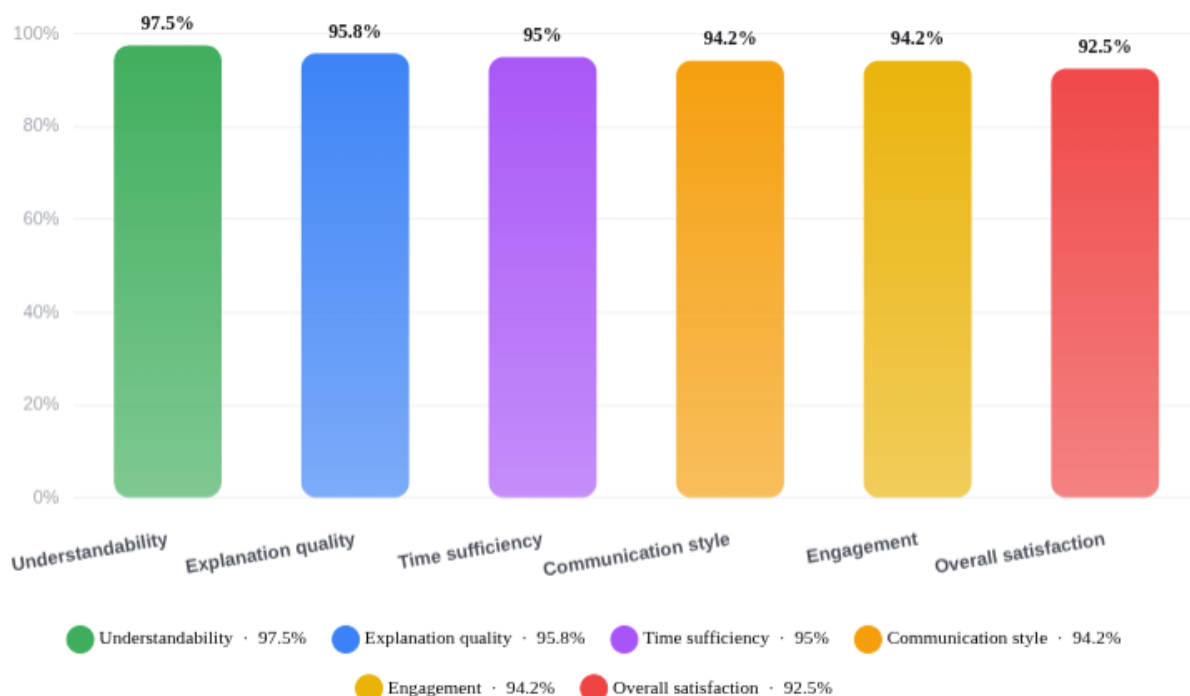


Feedback Analysis:
